Together with neighboring Lech, Zürs has been a member of the Best of the Alps club for many years, uniting the 12 best Alpine towns, and is considered the most luxurious Austrian resort.

The five-star Thurnher's Alpenhof is located at the foot of the Zürssee and Hexenboden cable cars, just like Zürs. It has two buildings in the spirit of an Alpine chalet, ideally inscribed in the mountain landscape of the resort. In the main - 14 suites and 24 suites, a restaurant, a lounge bar with an open fireplace and a panoramic sun terrace, a spa center with an indoor pool, saunas, a steam bath and a fitness room. Thurnher's Residences has five private suites ranging from 55 to 220 sq. m with an equipped kitchen, a spacious living-dining room, a bathroom with a jacuzzi, and sometimes a sauna, as well as round-the-clock service and concierge services. Thurnher's Residences can be rented entirely and lived in a company. And if you feel like a change of scenery, the main building is only 100 meters away and you have free access to all areas and services of Thurnher's Alpenhof.

Thurnher's Alpenhof has a design with local flair that looks modern and fresh. The interiors are full of beautiful wood and textiles with luxurious prints by Pierre Frey, Andrew Martin and Jim Thompson. The rooms look homely and cozy, and no two are alike. In addition, before the opening of the new season, the decorating team updates every room and public areas. The alpine spirit of the hotel and the five-star level of service remain unchanged. 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Another pride of the hotel is its restaurant, which is run by chef Yannick Ingenhoff. Culinary compositions are complemented by rare wines and breathtaking views of the white slopes of the Arlberg Mountains.

Winter in Zürs is gentle: there are no winds here, as on glaciers, and thanks to the special microclimate, the snow cover remains from mid-December to mid-April. Skiing in Zürs will appeal to anyone who gets up on skis. The southern slope is suitable for children and beginners, and the northern slope is suitable for professionals. Snowboarders will appreciate several fun parks, cross-country skiers will appreciate the slopes between Lech and Zürs, and climbers will appreciate Tyrol's only winter climbing slope in the Rendl region. And if you want to easily and beautifully conquer the untouched snowy slope, there is a heli-ski option at your service.



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Resting in Thurnher's Alpenhof, routes can be changed at least every day and never repeat. Thanks to three new ski lifts linking Zürs with Lech and St. Anton, the ski area now extends for 305 km and allows you to run all the slopes with a single ski pass. If you want a fast ride, steep slopes, "red" and "black" slopes, you should head for St. Anton, and if you practice the Slow Life philosophy and skiing without fuss and records, the Zürs-Lech route is ideal.

Roman Dornauer conquers steep slopes with professionals and teaches young guests how to ski in a playful way.
